

## **Application Procedures**

The applicants who wish to study in Oxbridge College, KUST may register in the International Affairs Office. Procedures are as follow:

1. An international student can download the Application Form from the website
2. An international student is required to submit the following materials:
  - The completed “Oxbridge College, KUST Application Form for International Students”
  - Photocopy of the passport page with student photo
  - Personal statements, indicating the applicant’s Chinese learning background, study plan and goals in China. The statement should be no less than 200 words, printed in either Chinese or English and signed by the applicant.
  - Certificates of Chinese Proficiency could be Chinese Proficiency Certificates and transcripts, or other certificates of Chinese language learning and/or education.
  - Diploma and transcripts(issued directly by the educational administration office of the school/university, and with a school cache ); Applicants for undergraduate studies are required to provide notarized copy of senior high school transcripts. Documents in language other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English.
  - Recommendation Letter from Former School
  - Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form (printed by Chinese quarantine authority and only for those whose period of studies in China lasts up to six months) filled in English. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the

hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicant are invalid.

- Applications under the age of 18 should submit letters of approval and provide emergent contact of their legal guardians.

The above application materials should reach the International Affairs Office by May 31 every year.

3. Any applicant admitted by Oxbridge College, KUST will receive the Offer, JW202 (Visa Application Form for Foreigners) from the college. If the applicant has applied the Confucius Institute Scholarship successfully, the college will notify him/her in the offer letter.
4. The applicant admitted should bring his passport, Offer, JW202 (Visa Application Form for Foreigners) to the Embassy or Consulate of the People's Republic of China nearby and applies for a "X" visa.
5. The applicant admitted should bring his Offer, JW202 (Visa Application Form for Foreigners) to register before the deadline at the International Affairs Office.
